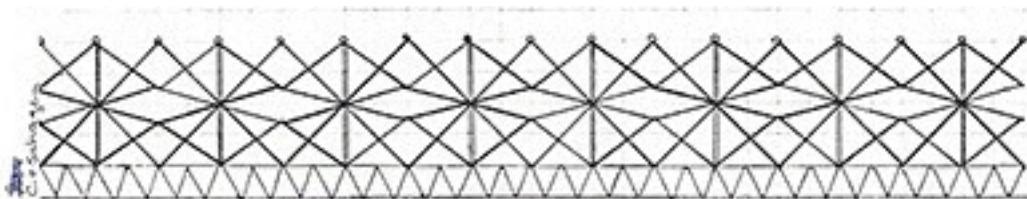
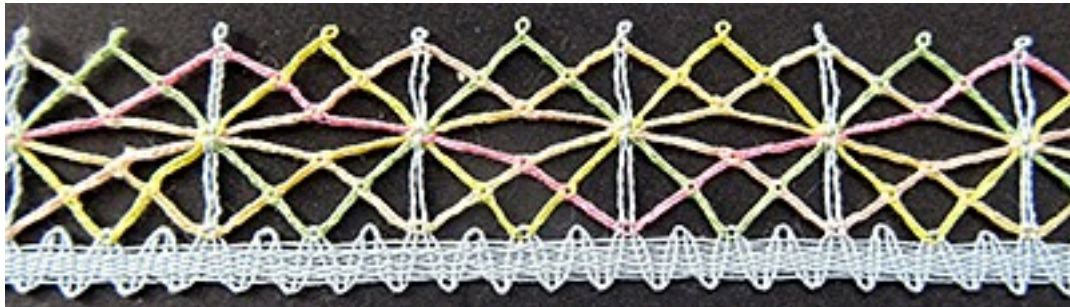


Week 14

This edging is really a lace with plaits. It is designed and made by Christa van Schagen. You need 18 pairs of bobbins with DMC 80 or similar.



The plaits are an important part of this edging. They cross each other and the workers of the tape along the inside in the centre of each motif in a 9-pairs crossing. The 9-pairs crossing is made the same way as the 5-pairs crossing of last weeks edging. Hang the plaits from the righthand side over the pin, work the workers through the plaits with 1 cloth stitch, assuming that the pairs on the right and on the left of the pin are one bobbin, twist the workers once and return on the same way to the tape along the inside. Then finish the crossing with half stitches assuming that the most right pairs on each side of the pin are 1 bobbin and the others also. Continue until all plaits have crossed each other and are going the own way in the same direction.
