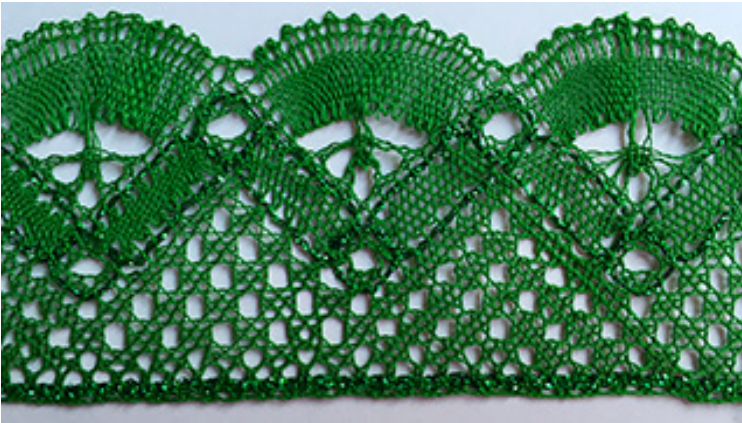


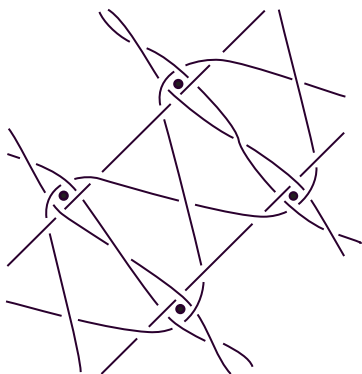
## Week 7

This is another special fan. I like the fans in the Torchon. This is a Spanish fan. It is pretty dense so we make vierges in the triangles to keep them open. Also the area between the gimps is filled in half stitch. YOU need 28 pairs of bobbins with DMC fil de dentelle nr. 80 or similar and 1 pair with a gimp.

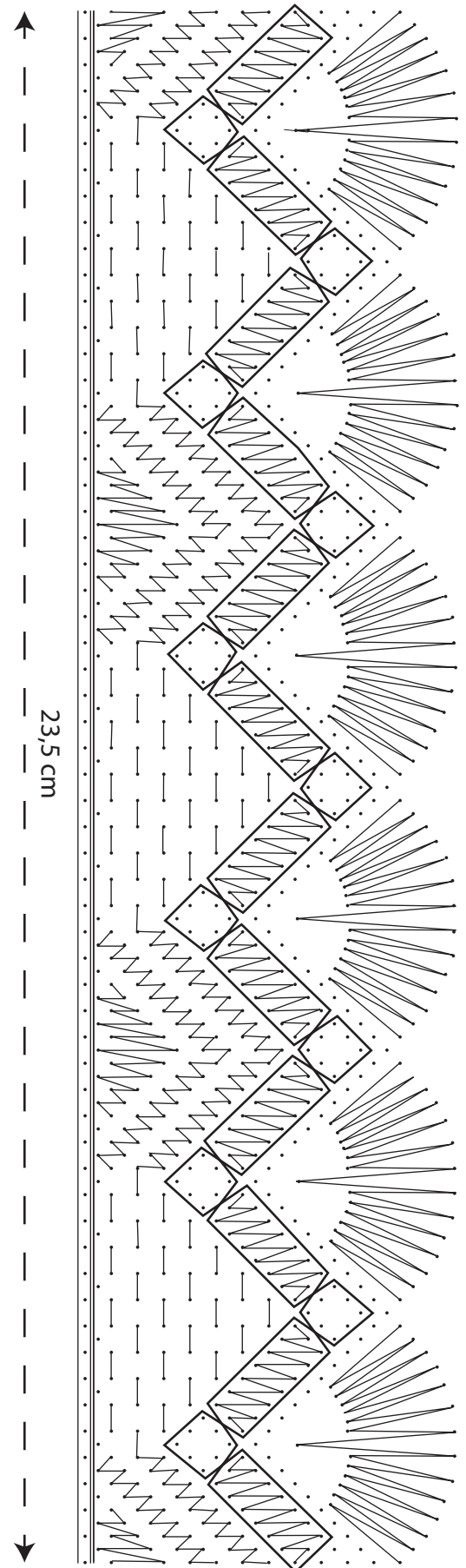


The Spanish fan is made in cloth stitch with 2 pairs at the outside in whole stitch. The workers are twisted twice between those 2 pairs and also before the cloth stitch. De Spaanse waaier wordt in linnenslag geklost met aan In the row to the centre of the fan the workers are twisted 3 times like the 4 pairs which are waiting there. Then work the workers in cloth stitch through those 4 pairs and back. Twist the workers 3 times before the cloth stitch of the fan. Als the 4 pairs, which are return to the torchon ground are to be twisted 3 times.

Next to the triangle in cloth stitch are 2 rows of Rose Ground 2. This is not on the photo, because there I filled the triangle completely with the Rose Ground 2.

The other triangle is filled with Rose Ground 8. See the thread diagram below.
