

Week 10

This week we start with a new series of laces, namely the Nyytinki laces from Finland. These laces originate from Karelia. They were used in the traditional costume of this region, mainly on the summer aprons. These laces used to be worked without a pattern and only with pins at the edges. To make it more convenient for you we made a pattern.

You need 18 pairs of bobbins with linen 80/2 or similar;
14 pairs in white and 4 pairs in a contrasting color, i.e. red.



The thread diagram on the next page shows how this insertion is worked. The pairs on both sides of the pairs in cloth stitch are the ones in the other color.
