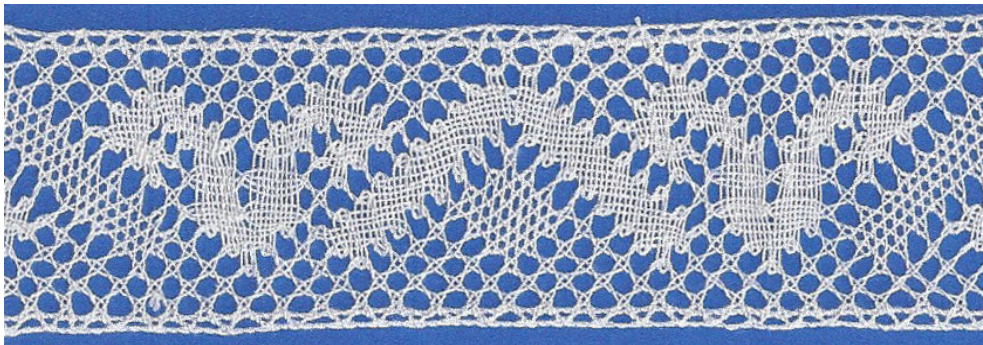
Included in this insertion there are 2 traditional motifs of the Petterson lace, which also exist in the Skåne laces: the diagonals and the tulips.

Originally this lace is made on a pricking of only pinholes.

On this pricking more than one lace can be made. The laceworker places the pins only there where the pattern requires it. This will be only at the edges and along the motifs. No pins in the ground. This means in this case only pins on the black dots, no pins on the grey dots in the ground.

This insertion is designed for us by Bep Hoogerbrugge.

You need 20 pairs of bobbins with linen 50/2 or 60/2 or similar



The diagonals and the diamond in half stitch won't be any problem. For the tulip see the diagram shown below.
