Edging for a handkerchief.

Necessary: 11 pairs of bobbins. Thread: Mez Protocord 50 or sewing cotton, ie. in 2 colors.

Although this edging also has a scallop, I don't think it is Dutch lace. It is more likely guipure.



START SCALLOP:

At the right: 2 pairs, 1 dark color for the edge and 1 light for the runners.

Centre: 2 pair light color

Left: 1 pair dark

The edgepair is in whole stitch, the other pairs are in cloth stitch

3rd row + 1 pair dark 4th row + 1 pair dark

START TAPE AT THE INSIDE:

Left: 2 pair dark color for the straight edge. Right: 2 pairs light color in cloth stitch.

BETWEEN TWO SCALLOPS:

The runners coming from left twist twice.

1th pair from the scallop twist 4 times.

The other 2 pairs twist 3 times.

Work the runners in cloth stitch through the pairs coming from the scallop. Twist once between those pairs. Return mirrored
