



The first edging is Schneeberg lace, designed by Lia Baumeister For this 6 pairs of bobbins with DMC fil de dentelle 80 or similar are needed.



This edging is made with 6 pairs of bobbins: 3 hanging pairs, 1 pair of workers and 2 pairs for the plait. As long as there is a line in the middle whole stitch has to be worked. To keep the middle hanging pair in the centre of the whole stitch, twist the workers extra. On one side along the edging the plait is worked. Exchange the workers with one of the pairs of plait on every pinhole as indicated on the pattern. See the drawing:



When this line disappears, work cloth stitch. The plait is no longer following the pinholes but is worked on its own with picots.



In the sharp curve returnstitches (twist/cross/twist/twist/cross) are to be made with the workers and the middle hanging pair until the zigzag continues.
