
Week 7

This is the 5th insertion in Torchon lace and for now it is the last Torchon lace. Surely we will do Torchon lace later. This weeks design is again of Bep (Elma) Hoogerbrugge. The lace is made by Agnes van Breemen.

You need 18 pairs of bobbins with Fil de dentelle 80 or similar.





There is no diagram. The pattern is easy to follow. The ground can be made in every stitch you like. But be careful. If you use a different color for the workers in the cloth stitch parts, that they go in a straight line to the other side.

Between those colored pairs and the cloth stitch elements a honeycomb is made.

Have fun with this insertion this week. Which lace type we will come with next week, is a surprise.
